SB 6181 Mala Adhikari; Kaiser Santa Clara 27-year-old woman with 8.4cm complex cystic and solid ovarian mass on ultrasound.

SB 6182 Walden Browne; Kaiser Oakland 53-year-old man with diarrhea. Colon biopsy performed to rule out microscopic colitis.

SB 6183 Megan Troxell; Stanford 62-year-old diabetic woman with nephrectomy for clear cell RCC; non-neoplastic kidney section submitted. Creatinine rose from 1.1 to 2.0 after surgery.

SB 6184 Greg Rumore; Kaiser Walnut Creek 51-year-old woman with posterior thigh cyst.  DIAGNOSIS:
SB 6185 Nabeen Nayak; Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, New Dehli A 34-yr-old woman was referred to the Gastroenterology service because of lower abdominal pain and constipation for 5 days with no other comorbidity. Except for some lower abdominal fullness, routine physical examination and investigations revealed no significant abnormality. Thoraco-abdominal CT scans showed an ill-defined mass 10x9.6 cm in right pelvis inseparable from that side ovary. Diagnostic laparoscopy showed abdominal caking and some hemoperitoneum in that area adherent to right ovary with nodules (? metastatic) in lower omentum. Multiple biopsies were taken.
