

















 56-year-old woman with 2cm yellow-orange, solid rubbery ovarian mass found during hysterectomy for leiomyomas.















































 39-year-old woman status post 6 cycles of R-CHOP and cardiomyopathy with persistent low grade fevers, hepatomegaly of unclear cause.
